



As a Southern California Kaiser Permanente member, you have access to 7 fertility centers throughout the area and multiple community IVF centers.

Many Kaiser Permanente members have coverage for the diagnosis and treatment of infertility, and some members have coverage for in vitro fertilization (IVF) procedures if IVF is listed as a covered benefit in the Evidence of Coverage for their Kaiser Permanente health benefit plans.

Effective January 1, 2020, certain fertility preservation services are a covered benefit for some plans under California law. For these plans, when a covered treatment may directly or indirectly cause iatrogenic infertility, standard fertility preservation services are a covered service distinct from covered infertility treatment services. "latrogenic infertility" means infertility caused directly or indirectly by surgery, chemotherapy, radiation, or other medical treatment.

Clinical services are provided by providers or contractors of Southern California Permanente Medical Group, and Kaiser Foundation Hospitals may receive compensation for providing facilities and/or other support in connection with these services.
